### 「全球瞭望角 Global Vision Corner」

#### 課程簡章

##### 壹、主旨 Purpose

提供本校學生學習不同語言的機會，以拓展國際視野，並透過不同語言小組，提供參與之同學多元之思考並同時促進本地生，境外生與英語母語人士之交流，提升本校國際化成效。詳細辦法及流程如下：

This course is meant to introduce various topics of current relevance to students and provide opportunities to share experiences and practice language skills. International students' experiences are varied and often invisible to local students. Conversely, local students' daily lives may still remain just out of reach. As such, these discussions will provide a gateway for local students and international students to engage in the daily lives of each other while sharing similarities and differences in thinking and behavior within those discussions. Through these discussions, it is hoped that new understandings will be entertained, boundaries broken and a new freedom to share and learn about those around you will be opened.

五、本課程為微學分課程，研究生因無相對應可抵認之自由選修課程，故無法登錄學分。大學部學生參加本課程，需經本中心及所屬學系認定後可抵認自由選修學分，注意事項如下所示：

(一) 本課程為微學分課程，適用於本校大學部學生，**單一課程累計達 36 小時**（每學期至少累積達 18 小時），則認列自由選修課程 2 學分，列入下學期學分。**未達 36 小時者，不予列入學分計算。**研究所學生因無相對應之自由選修可認列，故無法登錄學分。

(二) 自由選修學分需由學系認定，須先向所屬系辦確認該課程學分是否可認列自由學分，再行選修本課程。確認選修後，視同修習本課程，不得任意退選。

(三) 課程中每次上課均點名，全程修滿為 22 小時。不論假別請假超過 3 次以上者，則無法列入學分計算。

Global Vision Corner is a pass/fail course. Please note that graduate students can sign up for this course but will not get the credits. Undergraduate students who would like to waive credits with this course must confirm that his/her department acknowledges the credits of the course before signing up for this class.

1. This course is a pass/fail course. Students must attend the class for at least 36 hours in two semester **(at least 18 hours of attendance for each semester.)** Credits will only be recognized when students fulfill the abovementioned requirement and will be issued in the following semester.

2. The credits of the course must be acknowledged by the designated department. Please confirm if the credits can be acknowledged or not before signing up for the class. Students cannot drop out after the class begins.

3. The session will be on every Wednesday from 2:00 to 4:00 pm, and the class will last for 11 weeks, which is 22 hours in total per semester. The instructor will roll call whenever in class. The credits cannot be counted as valid once a student is absent from class for 3 times or more regardless of the reasons of absence.

### Grading criteria (評分標準)

1. This is a Pass or Fail class and no numerical class grade value will be assigned to students.
2. **Presentation:** Students will prepare a presentation on a subject of their choice as taken from the syllabus topics or a topic of their choosing. The presentation can be a group presentation or in-dividual. Presentations will

be on the last day of class. Your presentation topic and group members must be decided by the 6th week of class.

3. There will be one (1) reflection paper. **ALL PAPERS MUST BE SENT VIA EMAIL US-ING .docx FORMAT.** Please include your name on the paper. Each paper and the final paper will receive a “grade” to assess your progress for which you will also receive feedback.
4. Final paper: “What do I think now?” is the prompt for the final paper. This paper is for you to think critically about how you engage with the world around you, in any language ex-change, the topics of discussion and your experience in your life, and any new ideas you gained from the discussions. The paper must be a minimum of 1 full page and no more than 5 pages, 12pt font and double spaced. Papers can be sent to my email: [bmonri-co2016@gmail.com](mailto:bmonri-co2016@gmail.com). #### **Course requirements (課程要求)**

1. Responsible use of electronic devices is permitted however no phone calls should be answered during the class.
2. Food that will in no way distract from the class (smelly, loud and crunchy or packaged in a way that will make noise) may be eaten unless it is against the university policy to eat in the classroom.
3. Students are expected to attend class regularly and participate as fully as possible. You are not able to miss more than three (3) meetings or six (6) hours total. If more than 3 meetings are missed, you cannot pass the course.
4. Students are encouraged to bring in materials that may be interesting for class discussion or a response to previous discussion.
5. All other guidelines for student conduct as outlined in university policy will be adhered to.
